# Student Eligibility for Retroactive Fall 2024 Funding

- Retroactive fall payments are for required tuition and fees.
- Both Opportunity Scholarship and ESA+ new awards can pay retroactively, but only for required tuition and fees.

Note that ESA+ award funds can be used for **supplemental service expenses** incurred only as of the ClassWallet deposit date.



Students who ...

were attending by October 1, 2024, and are continuing into the spring semester at the same school.





There are two scenarios for <u>dual awarded</u> <u>students</u> where Opportunity Scholarship will <u>**not**</u> pay for the fall *even if the criteria we just explained is met*.

- Student already receives ESA+ and received Opportunity on December 3.
  - ESA+ and Opportunity will both pay for the spring.
- Student was awarded both ESA+ and Opportunity on December 3.
  - The ESA+ award pay for the fall.
  - ESA+ and Opportunity will both pay for the spring.





Certifying December New Student Awards The student began attending your school prior to October 1, 2024, and will continue into the 2025 spring semester.



# Students who did <u>not</u> attend by October 1<sup>st</sup> and are currently attending your school:



Whether or not you charged fall tuition to the parent, certify these students with their Individual Cost equal to the Spring Cost. **Fall Cost will equal 0.** 



The student began attending your school prior to October 1, 2024, and has already withdrawn, or won't be continuing into the next semester.




*No, because the student withdrew (or won't be continuously enrolled into January).*

# Whether or not the student attended for a portion of the fall semester, certify these students as "NO".



### Certifying Students Awarded on December 3

It is important to complete certification and endorsement both *accurately* and timely.

<u>**Pause</u>** before endorsing to verify the cost of attendance was entered accurately based on:</u>

- First date of attendance
- Last date of attendance
- Cost of attendance



Schools are responsible for providing accurate information when certifying.



## Reimbursement Guidelines

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### **Reimbursement to Parents**

- 1. Schools certify and endorse.
- 2. Parents endorse.
- 3. SEAA sends fall payments to schools. SEAA expects to disburse retroactive fall payments between January 6 – 17.
- 4. Schools reimburse families.
  - Reimbursement option must be offered to families.
  - Reimburse within 60 days of receiving the fall award payment.
