Before You Apply

The 2025-2026 (New Student) Opportunity Scholarship Application will open on February 6, 2025

What will you need?

Need:

- Parent of Record's Social Security
 Number or Individual Taxpayer
 Identification Number
- Student(s) Social Security Number.
- Parent of Record's <u>Driver's License</u> <u>Number</u>
- Annual household income amount for tax year <u>2024 only</u>

DON'T:

- Email tax return documents
- Email pictures of your driver's license
- Email pictures of your Social Security
 Card





Choosing a Direct Payment School

Direct Payment Schools

The Opportunity Scholarship can <u>only</u> be used at Direct Payment Schools. These are schools that have agreed to accept direct disbursements on behalf of students and have met the requirements to register with our agency.

How To Apply

How to Apply - Opportunity Scholarship

MyPortal Parent Responsibilities



- The parent of record must be a parent with whom the child lives.
- Only one parent can be listed in the MyPortal record, and that parent should be the only person responsible for accessing the MyPortal account.
- Children of divorced or separated parents are part of the household that has more than 50% custody.
- If you share equal custody, you may choose who the parent of record will be.

Tip: Need to update your email?

Update your email address in two sections in MyPortal = My Contact Information & User Profile

Tip: Is the parent who primarily manages Opportunity Scholarship business *not* the parent who is listed in MyPortal?

Email Opportunity Scholarship and request to change the parent of record.



Step #2: Add Students then Apply

- Add student(s) to your MyPortal parent account and complete your application(s)
- Parents applying for more than one new student should submit a separate application for each student and enter the same household size & income for each student
- After you submit the application, you will be notified whether your student is eligible to receive the award and their Award Tier amount
- Use the <u>Award Tier</u> amount provided in the notification to calculate how much the scholarship may cover at your school of choice

✓ Apply by March 6

Eligible applications submitted between February 6 - March 6 will be awarded based on household income, starting with Award Tier 1. Scholarships will be offered to families in Award Tiers 2-4 as funds remain available. For more information, see the <u>Awarding Process</u> page.





2024 Household Income & Award Tiers

How to accurately calculate your 2024 income

Scholarships are awarded based on a family's 2024 household income

- Please review our <u>Income Calculator</u> and <u>Income FAQ</u> for tips on calculating your income. For the purposes of the scholarship program, we require the reporting of all taxable or untaxable money received, before deductions, by all members of your household for 2024.
- We define a **household member** as anyone who lives with you and shares income and expenses of the household.
- Provide your best estimate of the income received (before deductions) by your household during 2024 using the Income Calculator. Refer to our <u>Income Chart to</u> <u>determine your student's Award Tier.</u>



How Much Could a Parent Owe?

Household Size = 4
Total Income for 2024 = \$154,000
AWARD TIER 3

In this example, each student is awarded **up** to \$4,612 (AWARD TIER 3) and the parent is trying to decide between two schools.

Awarding Process

Check MyPortal for Notifications

Early April

Check MyPortal regularly for an award offer or waitlist notification. If your student receives an award offer, you will have a deadline to accept or decline your student's award in MyPortal.

If the number of eligible applications exceeds the amount of funds available, students will be added to a waitlist to fill slots that <u>may</u> become available at a later date.

After an Award: What are the Next Steps?



Reminders:

- ✓ Scholarships are awarded <u>per</u> <u>student</u>, not per household. Parents should regularly check each student's record in MyPortal for required tasks that must be completed.
- ✓ Be sure your email address stored in MyPortal is one you regularly use.
- ✓ Review the <u>Awarding Process</u>.

Now What?

Check MyPortal for Notifications

Mid-April through July

Let's suppose your student received an Opportunity Scholarship award offer. Now what?

<u>All</u> applications are subject to <u>Income</u> and/or Residency verification. If you are selected for Income or Residency Verification, we have <u>resources</u> to help you complete the process.

Reminders:

✓ Complete tasks by the set deadline in MyPortal.





How do schools receive your student's scholarship funding?

Payment Timeline

August: Certification (schools do this)

August / September: Endorsement and Payment to Schools (FALL)

January / February: Endorsement and Payment to Schools (SPRING)

Review the timeline!





Parent Obligations

Parent Responsibilities

DO:

- Ensure your contact information is updated
- Keep an eye on deadline dates in MyPortal
- Submit documentation via MyPortal if requested
- Allow your student to be tested (3rd grade and higher; your school is required to test)

DON'T:

- Give anyone your MyPortal credentials (not even your school)
- Request or accept a refund of scholarship funds from your school

Parents, do check MyPortal at least once a week as long as your student is connected to the Opportunity Scholarship Program!
